


- I. Ms. Bradberry called the meeting to order at 5:37 p.m.
- II. Mr. Young opened the meeting in prayer.
- III. Public Comments: None
- IV. Mr. Young moved to approve the March 2021 financials and invoices. Mr. Powell seconded. Ms. Ferguson moved to approve the March 22, 2021 Regular Board Meeting Minutes. Mr. Young seconded. Motions passed unanimously.
- V. Mr. Howell presented the Hospital Administrator's report.
- VI. Ms. Hudson presented the EMS Administrator's Report.
- VII. Ms. Ferguson moved to table the discussion and possible action to amend Sabine County Hospital District bylaws to reflect changes to board terms made in the Regular Session Board Meeting on September 26, 2011. Mr. Young seconded. Motion passed unanimously.
- VIII. Ms. Ferguson moved to approve the sealed bids from Linebarger Goggen Blair & Sampson, LLP. Mr. Young seconded. Motion passed unanimously.
- IX. Board Member Comments: Mr. Young asked Mr. Howell how they could let the public know about the improvements being made to the hospital. Mr. Howell stated that he would be in contact with the local news.

Ms. Bradberry asked Mr. Howell what the visitation policy was at the hospital. Mr. Howell stated that the policy is one visitor per patient and no visitors in the Emergency Room due to no waiting area unless the patient is unable to make decisions. Mr. Howell stated that the policy would continue to be updated as Covid requirements changed. Mr. Howell also stated that he was thinking of doing a vaccine clinic in the evening or on the weekend so working people would be able to attend and be vaccinated. He stated he also wanted to reach out to local businesses to see if they wanted to allow their employees an opportunity to be vaccinated at work.
